
- The IEEE Computer Society traces its origins back to 1946. For more than 70 years, our members have played a central role in the rapid evolution of computer technologies
- We've grown from a small group of specialists to an international organization with more than 50,000 members who are dedicated to advancing all aspects of computer science and engineering.


What we do

Awards and Fellowships

Lance Stafford Larson Student Award

Type: Student Paper contest.

Introduced by: Larson family to encourage students to develop excellence in their communication skills and to motivate students toward achievement in the field of Computer Science.

Prize amount: \$500 is given each year to the first place winner.

Eligibility: All IEEE student members.

Application deadline: Oct 31 of each year.

Richard E Merwin Scholarship (REM)

Introduced by: This scholarship was created in honor of the late Richard E. Merwin, past president of the IEEE Computer Society, to recognize and reward student leadership.

Prize Amount: Over a dozen scholarships of \$1,000 and up are available, for one academic year (approximately 9 months).

Eligibility Criteria: Il graduate and undergraduate students who are IEEE Computer Society members and full-time students at an academic institution are eligible. With a minimum GPA of (2.5 / 4.0)

Nomination Deadline(s): 30 April and 30 September

Upsilon Pi Epsilon Award

Aim: To encourage academic excellence for students in the computing discipline.

Introduced by: UPE in association with IEEE CS.

Prize amount: Up to four awards of \$1,000 each are given each year to competition winners.


Eligibility: All graduate and undergraduate students who are IEEE Computer Society members and full-time students at an academic institution are eligible.


Nomination Deadline: 31 Oct each year.


